- When we receive this application, we will send you or your agent an acknowledgement letter within 5 working days.
- You are required by law to advertise your application. Provided the croft is registered with the Keeper of the Registers of Scotland, at the end of the 28 day consultation period we must decide whether or not to grant the application or to investigate further. If we decide to investigate further we will notify all interested parties. We aim to take a decision within 12 to 16 weeks where the croft is registered with the Keeper of the Registers of Scotland.
- Our decision can be appealed to the Scottish Land Court within 42 days from the date we notify interested parties of our decision.


